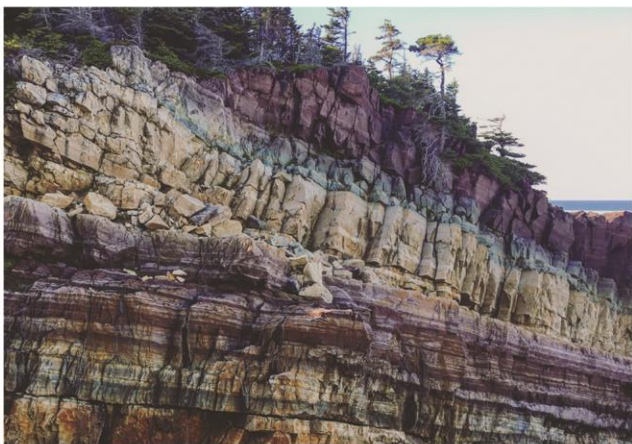

UNESCO Global Geoparks are single unified geographical areas, where sites and landscapes of international geological significance are managed with a holistic concept of protection, education, and sustainable development.

A UNESCO Global Geopark uses its geological heritage, in connection with all other aspects of the area's natural and cultural heritage, to enhance awareness and understanding of key issues, and uses best practices for economic development.
